The Participating States commit to commencing comprehensive program review no later than 2016 to consider program successes, impacts, potential additional reductions to the cap post-2020, and other program design elements."

The RGGI participating states will also use the regional 2016 Program Review stakeholder meetings as an opportunity to receive comments from stakeholders and experts on potential program changes in pursuit of compliance with the EPA Clean Power Plan. This meeting will solicit stakeholder input on RGGI program design elements, including considerations for potential compliance under the EPA Clean Power Plan.
